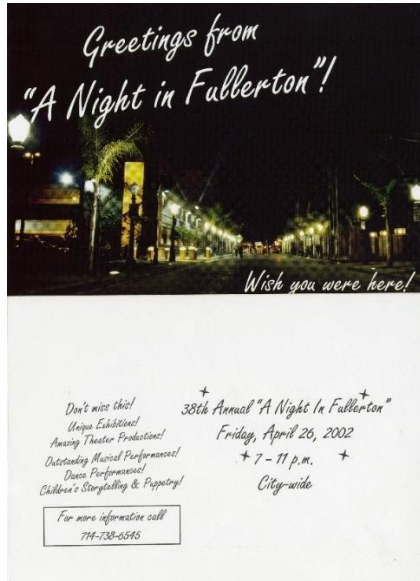

California Printmaker Gene Kloss exhibit

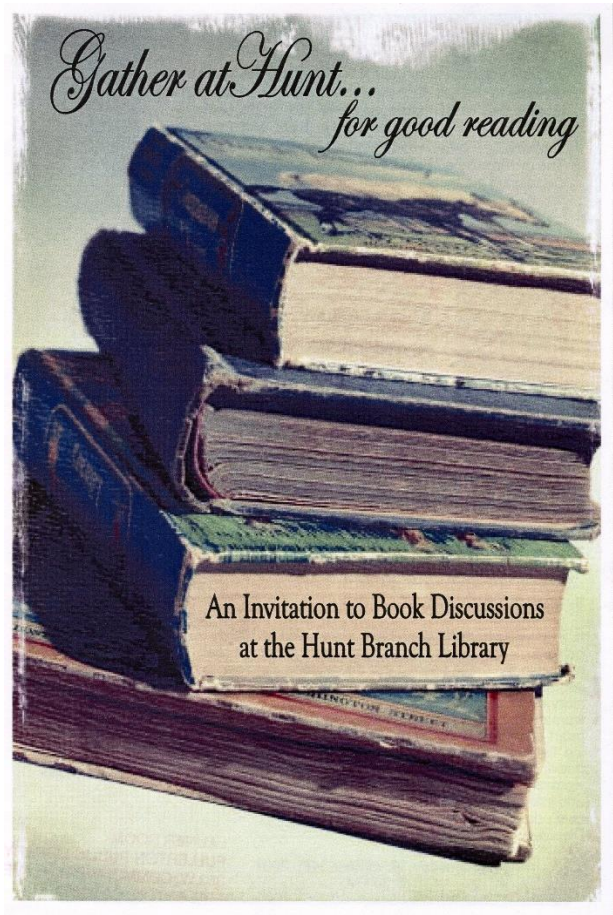


2005, February – “Take a Lap Around the Library” laptop program

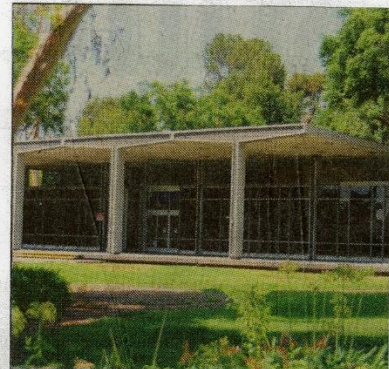

Hunt Library Closed

The Fullerton Public Library Board, at its March 28th meeting, voted on an emergency item to temporarily close the Hunt Branch Library due to increased problems with the homeless encampment. Homeless individuals from other towns are now camping at the site - swelling the population to about 60 regulars. There have been some incidents related to the encampment which have made library staff afraid to go to work. For budgetary reasons a longer closure of the Hunt will be considered at an upcoming special meeting.
