Mid-Summer Shindig Delights Audience!

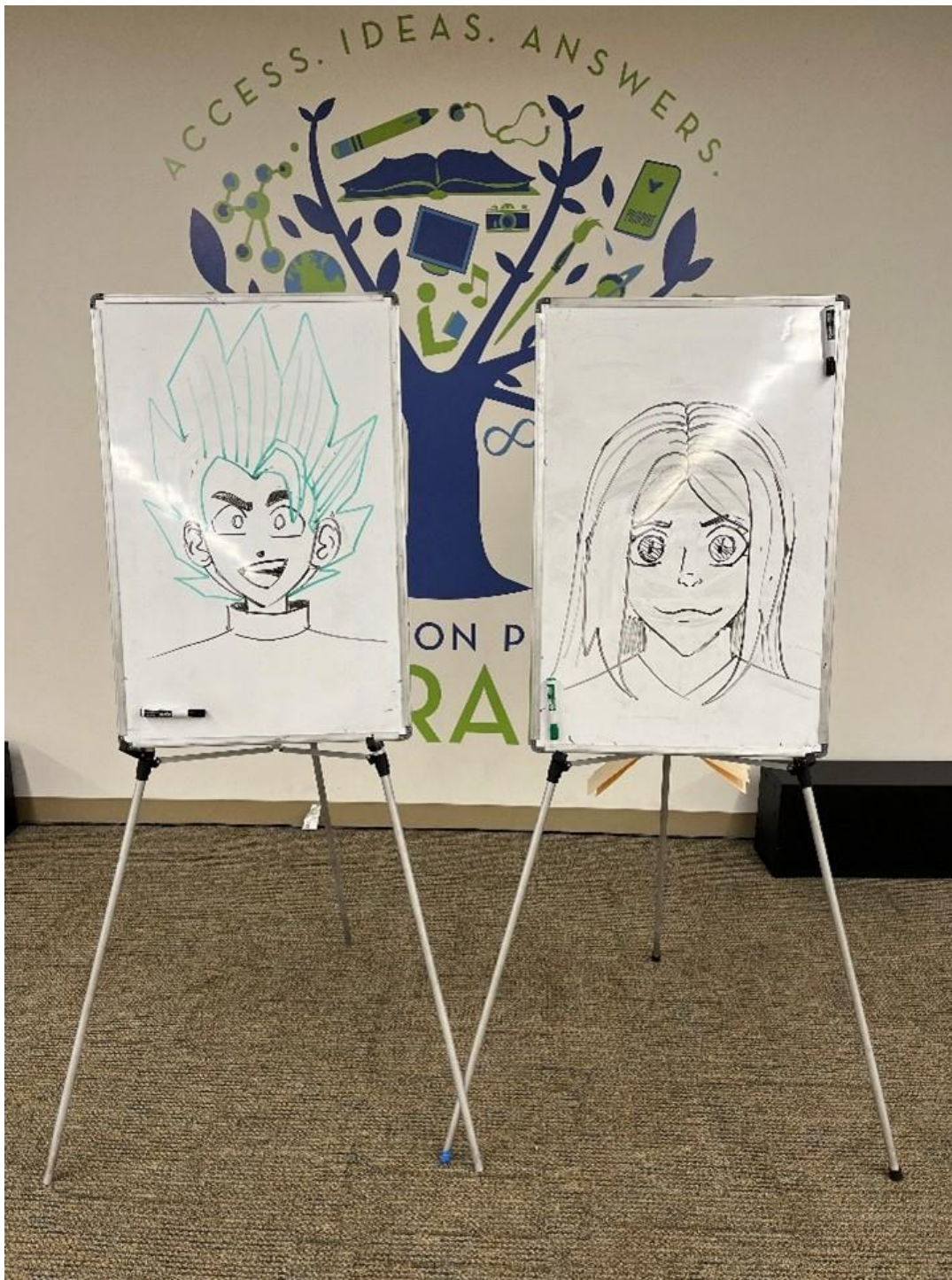
