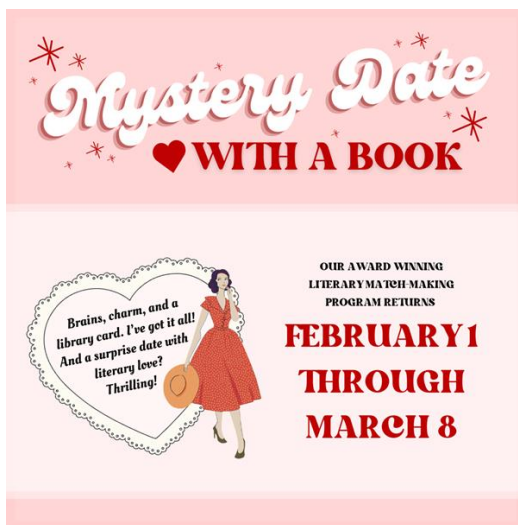

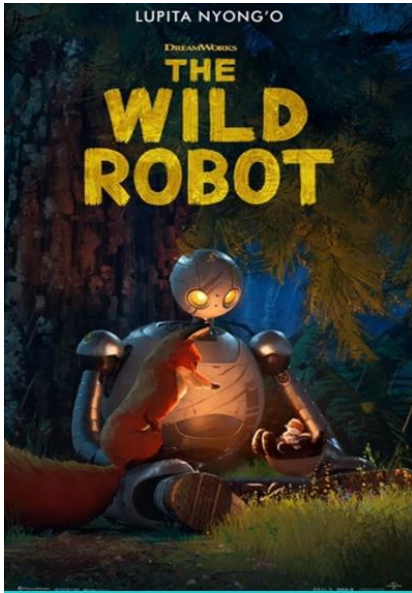

## Winter Reading Programs

The Children's Winter Reading Club concluded on January 11. The 2024-2025 program saw 248 children register and 181 children earn at least 1 prize. That means 73% of children participated in the Winter Reading Club! We also had 116 children complete the program and earn the last prize, a free book! Thanks to the generosity of the Friends of the Fullerton Public Library and our community partners--Zombee Donuts, Raising Cane's, Patty's Cakes, and Bruster's Ice Cream--we were able to distribute five levels of prizes to the children of Fullerton.

## Hunt Branch Library Celebrates Lunar New Year

Hunt Branch Library recently celebrated Lunar New Year with a grand storytime with over 160 attendees. In addition to celebrating Lunar New Year, the Fullerton Public Library Foundation was in attendance and gifted the Hunt Branch Library a donation of \$13,500 raised from previous fundraisers like their thirtieth anniversary event held at Hunt. We are extremely grateful for this donation, which will help the Hunt Branch grow its physical book collection!

To celebrate the special storytime, Hunt Branch library had guest author Judy Li read two of her books in English and Mandarin. After the storytime, attendees celebrated with various Lunar New Year activities like making their own Lucky Red Envelopes, Ddakji (a traditional Korean toy), Bogjumeoni (a Korean fortune pouch), and eating traditional celebratory snacks like Yakgwa (a Korean honey cookie pastry), Ganjeong (a Korean rice snack), lucky chocolate coins, and tangerines.
